cfop_id	JSON	ID of cfop Format: int(11) * FIELD REQUIRED
cfop_name_text	JSON	Main name of cfop Format: varchar(255) * FIELD REQUIRED
cfop_code	JSON	Code of cfop Format: varchar(255) * FIELD REQUIRED
