suppliers_id	JSON	ID of suppliers Format: int(11) * FIELD REQUIRED
suppliers_group_name	JSON	Main name of suppliers Format: varchar(255) * FIELD REQUIRED
suppliers_description	JSON	Description of suppliers Format: text * FIELD REQUIRED
